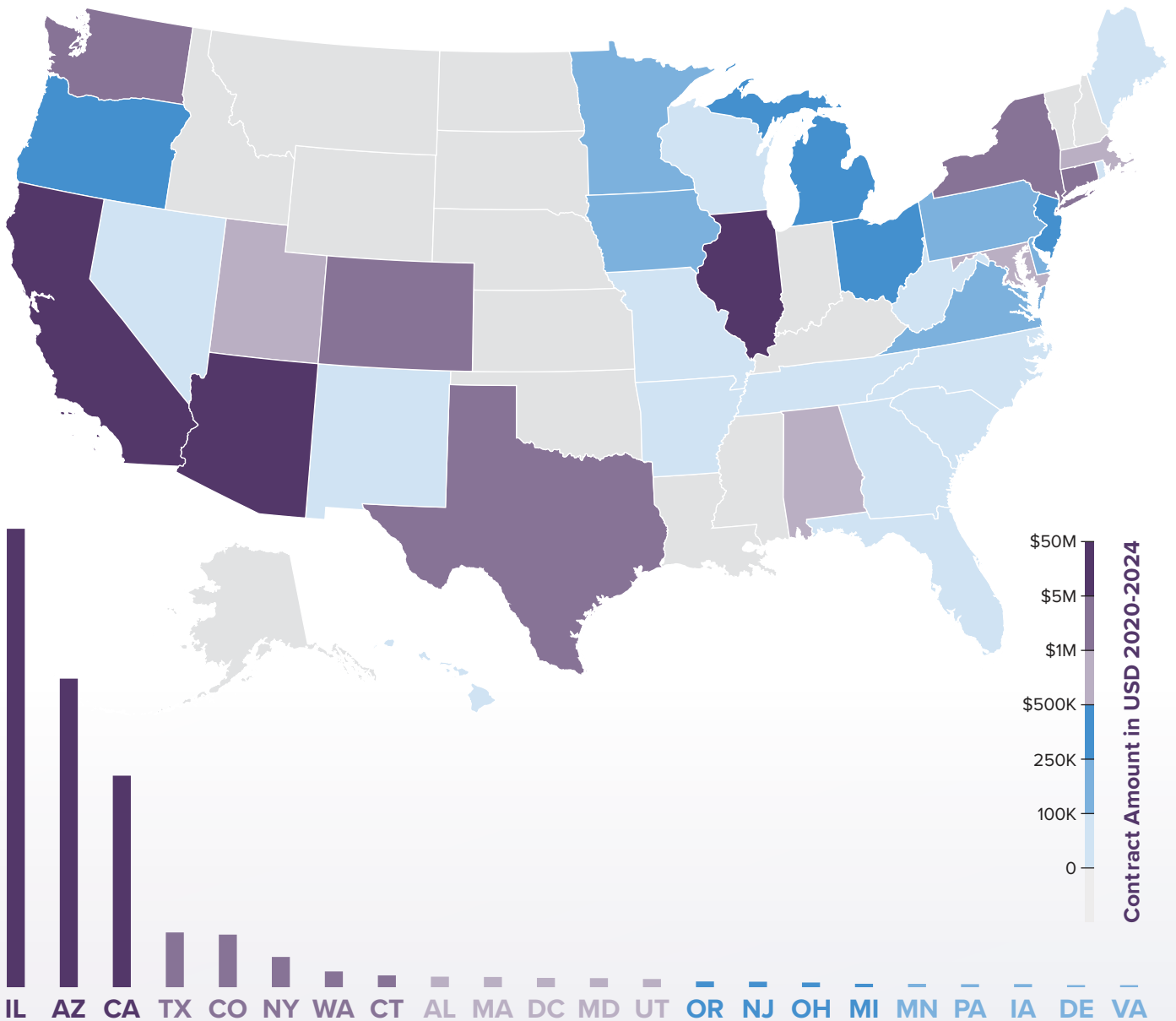




GIANT MAGELLAN TELESCOPE

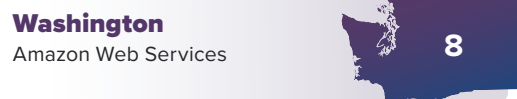
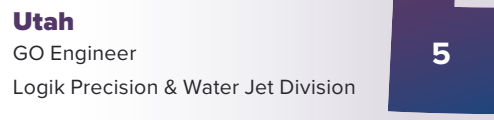
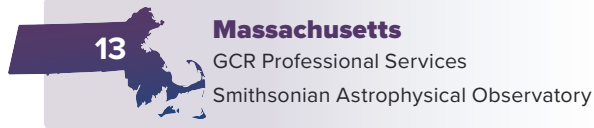
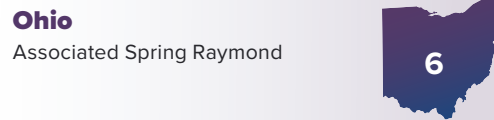
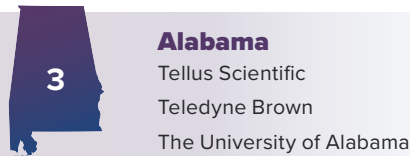
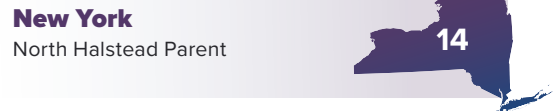
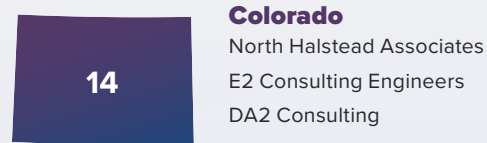
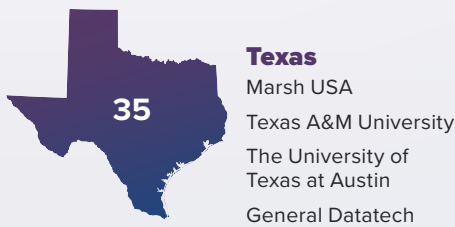
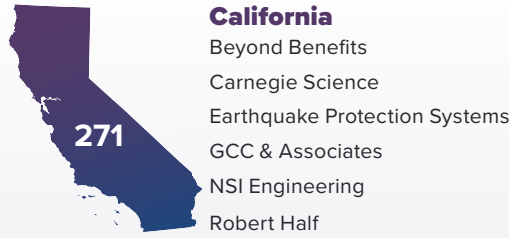
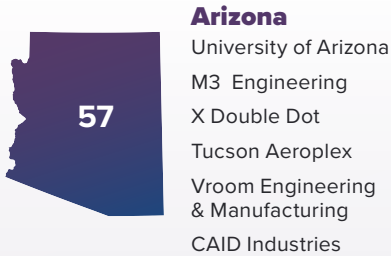


Keep America Building: Federal funding in FY 2025 and 2026 would keep more than \$50 million in jobs, research, and manufacturing in America.
